2022 The British Transplant Games is to be held in Leeds on 28-31 July. The Archery Day will be on **Thursday 28th July**. As always, we need many volunteers and sponsors to make this event the major success that it has become over the past few years.

The day starts with experienced archers, usually around 40-50 of them, followed by inexperienced / complete novice archers – usually around 120 of these in different age groups. To cater for these numbers in a tight timescale takes a lot of organisation, and we need the following people to volunteer to make it happen:

20-30 qualified AGB Coaches

Experienced archers to help with scoring, instructing

Equipment management – we need to borrow around 60 beginners weight bows- adult lengths - 200+ arrows of at least 28" and longer, 50-60 bracers

2-3 Judges

Field party for set up/take down of the range

We also need:

20 targets, preferably foam, tie down ropes and pegs

(Transport can be available the day before the event and targets will be returned either Thursday evening or Friday)

Sponsorship of target faces and pins – usually c 40 60cm faces and 30 80cm faces

All equipment being loaned will be insured for the duration and should be clearly identifiable so that it can be returned fully. Last year was very well managed and we had only 2 bracers left over!
