PLEASE NOTE

We will be asking all archers to show proof of a valid AGB membership at the tournament - please bring your card (electronic or physical)

The tournament will be conducted according to AGB Rules, Dress Regulations 307 will apply.

Shooting will be under AGB Rule 304. Paragraph (f) Method 2. (i.e. timed 6 arrow ends.)

Target lists will be sent out the week before the tournament. Target lists and results will be available on lanseo.

Whilst all that is practical will be done, the organisers cannot be held responsible for damage to carbon arrows passing through bosses.

All rounds to be shot that are eligible for record status will be WORLD RECORD STATUS, and so competitors will be liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must ensure that a parent guardian signs their entry form giving consent to a drug test if requested.

Under the provisions within the AGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with tournament Organiser on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, AGB, the Tournament Organiser working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code.

Any archer with a chronic medical condition is asked to notify the Tournament Organiser (in complete confidence) so that appropriate action can be taken in the event of recurrence.

AWARDS

1ST PLACED

Senior Lady and Gent recurve, compound, barebow and longbow archers will receive a trophy & medal

2ND & 3RD PLACED

Senior Lady and Gent recurve, compound barebow and longbow archers will receive a medal.

BEST OVERALL

Junior Lady & Gent will receive a trophy, other junior awards according to round entries.

The highest scoring couple residing at the same address will be awarded the Jack & Jill trophy.

A recurve team will consist of three archers from one club, including at least one lady or junior.

A compound team will consist of three archers from one club, including at least one lady or junior.

A barebow team will consist of three archers from one club.

A longbow team will consist of three archers from one club.
