- Target List/results will be posted on the Yorkshire Archery website.
- Thirsk Bowmen or YAA cannot be held responsible for arrows passing through targets.
- There will be 4 archers per target shooting in two details on foam bosses.
- GDPR - By entering this event you agree that the details given on this entry form may be published in documents or lists relating to the tournament, or for any archery award claims made at the shoot.

- Archers with a disability should inform the Tournament Organiser, at the time of entry, should they wish to stay on the shooting line. Every effort will then be made to place only 3 archers on the target.
- Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must ensure that a Parent or Guardian signs their entry form giving consent to a drug test, if required.
- YAA and Thirsk Bowmen shall be taking photographs during the event for use in connection with marketing. Every effort shall be made to avoid photographs being taken of persons under the age of 16. Those 16 and over not consenting to be included in photographs for the purpose outlined please advise the Tournament Organiser before shooting commences.
