



Directions:

Leave M1 Junction 40 and head towards Wakefield on the A638.

Pass through two sets of traffic lights and after the pedestrian lights turn right into Broadway.

Continue on Broadway to the T junction...turn right on the A642 Horbury Road.

Continue on A642 until you see sign for Horbury Junction and turn left into Daw Lane, then immediate right into Southfield Lane.

Turn left off Southfield Lane, over the railway line, then right to Slazenger's Sports Club.
