PLEASE NOTE

- Dress Regulations (Archery GB) Target Archery will be enforced.
- Entries are limited (the range can accommodate up to 32 bosses) and no subsequent substitutes will be allowed.
- Overall Junior Champion Trophies will be awarded to archers obtaining the highest scores irrespective of distance/round.
- Juniors to shoot the Archery GB round according to their age or any age band above.
- The Bristol 5 round is not Rose Award Status for Boys Under 10.
- Camping/Caravaning is not presently available.
- An e-mail confirmation will be sent if a readable e-mail address is given.
- Target List/results will be posted on the Yorkshire Archery website.
- Thirsk Bowmen or YAA cannot be held responsible for arrows passing through targets.

- There will be 4 archers per target shooting in two details on foam bosses.
- GDPR - By entering this event you agree that the details given on this entry form may be published in documents or lists relating to the tournament, or for any archery award claims made at the shoot.
- Archers with a disability should inform the Tournament Organiser, at the time of entry, should they wish to stay on the shooting line. Every effort will then be made to place only 3 archers on the target.
- Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must ensure that a Parent or Guardian signs their entry form giving consent to a drug test, if required.
- YAA and Thirsk Bowmen shall be taking photographs during the event for use in connection with marketing. Every effort shall be made to avoid photographs being taken of persons under the age of 16. Those 16 and over not consenting to be included in photographs for the purpose outlined please advise the Tournament Organiser before shooting commences.
