Format **WA720 with H2H**

World record status tournament shot to AGB rules.

Morning: World Record Status WA720 ranking round at 70m recurve and longbow, 60m recurve and 50m compound/barebow. Compound targets will have one 6-ring face per archer, whilst all other targets will have one 10-ring per target.

Afternoon: Head-to-head matches in each division.

Assembly 8.45am followed by two ends of official practise.

Rounds Adults: 70m recurve / 70m longbow / 50m compound / 50m barebow
Under 18's: Metric 122 or 80 at the various distances as required by age category.
Over 50's and under 21's are welcome to take part in the head-to-heads but will need to shoot the senior rounds.

Junior head-to-heads matches may mix genders and bow styles based on number of entries.

6 arrow ends in 4 minutes.

2ND & 3RD PLACE

Senior Lady and Gent recurve, compound, and barebow archers will receive a medal.

JUNIOR AWARDS

Junior awards will be awarded according to round entries.

Agents / Scorers

We ask anyone entering our competitions that require an agent/scorer that they bring someone along on the day of the competition to act as their agent/scorer. Please confirm on the entry form if you will have an agent.

We have a limited field party at the club who will have other duties on the day of the competition. Please contact the Tournament Organiser to discuss if you require an agent.

Dogs

Dogs are welcomed, however must stay behind the tent line. If they become noisy or aggressive, they must be removed from the archery field.

Archers competing in this event may be subject to drugs testing.

Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply; non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.

By entering this competition, you consent to testing. If you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor; this is in line with the UK Antidoping Policy, Rule 5.7.2.

Liability

Brontë Archers, judges or affiliated parties cannot accept liability for any loss, damage or injury however caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.

Any archer with a chronic medical condition is asked to notify the Tournament Organiser (in complete confidence) so that appropriate action can be taken in the event of recurrence.

Photos

Under the provisions within the AGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with Tournament Organiser on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, AGB, the Tournament Organiser working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code.

GDPR

By entering Brontë Archers competitions you agree that the information you provide may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, ArcheryGB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents relating to the event in the year of 2026. This information includes your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, e-mail address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information.

A target list will be published prior to the event, available on lanseo. Up-to-date information will be mostly available on lanseo. Results will be published as soon after the tournament as possible.

AGB Rules

By entering our competitions, you are agreeing to abide by AGB Rules of shooting and the regulations of these tournaments.

We will be asking all archers to show proof of a valid AGB membership at the tournament – please bring your card (electronic or physical)

A Junior's parent/guardian must sign on behalf of the Junior, and in the case of a Junior under 18 years must notify the Tournament Organiser of the senior person (entry form) who will be taking due care and responsibility for that junior the whole time he/she is on Brontë Archer's premises.
